Dear Majority Leader Schumer, Minority Leader McConnell, Speaker Johnson, and Minority Leader Jeffries,

We, the undersigned organizations, represent a cross-section of essential clinician and healthcare workforce stakeholders dedicated to caring for underserved communities. Our commitment is to strengthen the healthcare workforce and advance health equity, especially for individuals in medically underserved areas and Health Professional Shortage Areas (HPSAs). We are deeply concerned about the imminent expiration of mandatory funding for the National Health Service Corps (NHSC) and the Teaching Health Centers Graduate Medical Education (THCGME) program, which is set to end on December 31st.

Extending and enhancing funding for the NHSC and sustaining federal support for THCGME, which trains primary care physicians in community settings, are critical needs. As the nation faces severe healthcare workforce shortages—especially in rural and underserved areas—reauthorizing funding for these programs will help address patient care needs nationwide. For fifty years, the NHSC has addressed workforce shortages, and the THCGME program—the only federal initiative training future physicians in community-based settings—has enjoyed over a decade of bipartisan support.

We urge Congressional leaders to promptly reauthorize and invest in the NHSC and THCGME programs. S. 2840, the *Bipartisan Primary Care and Health Workforce Act*, introduced by Senators Sanders and Marshall, proposes to reauthorize mandatory NHSC funding at \$950 million per year for three years and to increase THCGME funding to \$300 million per year for five years. Our stakeholders commend Senators Sanders and Marshall for championing this bipartisan legislation, which sustains vital NHSC funding. Since 1972, the NHSC has placed over 75,000 healthcare providers in underserved areas, supporting 18,000 clinicians who care for more than 19 million people nationwide. The NHSC serves over 75 million people in primary care HPSAs by providing scholarships and loan repayment programs to healthcare providers committed to these communities.

Despite rising demand, NHSC funding has declined by nearly \$220 million in FY23 and almost \$90 million in FY24. An estimated \$965.6 million is needed in FY24 to meet growing needs and projected clinician shortages. As a nation, we are at a breaking point with respect to healthcare workforce shortages, particularly in underserved communities in every corner of the nation. This investment in the NHSC equates to sustaining an NHSC field strength of 20,000 clinicians. Now is a time when we can least afford to see a decline in the number of clinicians providing care in these high-need communities. The THCGME program, which has strong bipartisan support, currently trains nearly 1,200 medical and dental residents across 82 Teaching Health Centers in nearly 30 states. These residents provide care in over one million patient visits annually, addressing critical primary care shortages nationwide. The centers in this program, which place doctors where they are most needed, often receive over 100 applications for each residency slot. Many THCGME residents continue practicing in the communities where they trained, strengthening local healthcare systems and establishing long-term roots.

We urge you, along with the Senate Health, Education, Labor, and Pensions (HELP) Committee and the House Energy and Commerce Committee, to support the *Bipartisan Primary Care and Health Workforce Act*—an essential bipartisan effort to continue funding the Corps and the THCGME program, which together make healthcare more accessible to those most in need.
