

## Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) from the Informational Session

**Q:** How can I find more information about the Curriculum SCOPE Survey?

**A:** More information about the Curriculum SCOPE Survey is available at [www.aamc.org/SCOPE](http://www.aamc.org/SCOPE). On the website, you will find Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs), information about reports, and ways to stay connected.

**Q:** If my school participated in the inaugural Curriculum SCOPE Survey, how do I obtain a survey copy and/or my school's customized report?

**A:** Your curriculum dean is the authorized person to receive both the Curriculum SCOPE Survey and customized report(s) for your school. In order to obtain a copy of the Curriculum SCOPE Survey and/or view your school's customized report, you must contact your curriculum dean. If you are unsure of who to contact for access at your school, contact Aisha Ali ([aali@aacom.org](mailto:aali@aacom.org)).

**Q:** If my school did not participate in the inaugural Curriculum SCOPE Survey, how do I obtain a survey copy or report?

**A:** The best way to obtain a copy of the Curriculum SCOPE Survey is to join the AAMC Curriculum Virtual Community. You may sign in if you are already a member or register if you are not [here](#). If your school did not participate in the inaugural Curriculum SCOPE Survey, you are ineligible to receive a customized report since it is based on each school's response in comparison to the aggregate response of all participating schools. However, non-participating schools may receive the Curriculum SCOPE National Aggregate Statistics Report, which was shared with your medical school's curriculum dean. Medical school curriculum deans are empowered to determine who at their medical school should receive the report for curriculum-related activities, in accordance with the instructions and terms of use outlined within the report itself. **NOTE:** If joining the Curriculum Virtual Community, contact Aisha Ali ([aali@aacom.org](mailto:aali@aacom.org)) to assist in processing your request.

**Q:** I am a new school that was unable to participate in the inaugural Curriculum SCOPE Survey due to developing our school's curriculum at the time. Am I unable to receive a survey copy or report?

**A:** While your medical school is ineligible to receive a customized report since it is based on each school's response in comparison to the aggregate response of all participating schools, your medical school is able to view aggregate reports, such as the one covered during the informational session. Additionally, your medical school is eligible to view a copy of the survey. These materials have been shared with your medical school's curriculum dean.
